Tour Terms and Conditions

ALL-INCLUSIVE: The tour charge includes 6 nights accommodation, 2 meals per day, all entrance and activity fees for scheduled tours, luxury coach travel across the state (equipped with restroom, wifi and bottled water), guided tours and airport transfers. Communion service will be offered on Sunday evening, and group worship times will also be offered on Monday, Thursday and Friday evenings at the hotel. Jeff Jenkins will be the guest speaker.

TRANSPORTATION TO TOUR START IN PORTLAND: Individuals are to make their own flight or driving arrangements to and from Portland, Maine, for this trip. Airport transfers to/from the Portland International Jetport (PWM) are included. If you are arriving by car, parking for the week is available at our first/last hotel. The tour begins at the Portland Doubletree Hotel with welcome banquet at 6:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 11, 2022 and ends with hotel departure by 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 17, 2022. Once your flight reservation is made, please forward a copy of the itinerary to abundantliving@harding.edu and the airport transfer arrangements will be communicated.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Prices are based on luxury hotel accommodations at Doubletree by Hilton (Portland), Rockland Harbor Hotel (Rockland) and Atlantic Oceanside Resort (Bar Harbor).

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: \$500 per person is due at registration. Full payment must be received by Friday, May 13, 2022. Deposits and final payments are payable to Abundant Living. Cash, checks and credit cards accepted. To pay by credit card, call 501-279-4055. Limited seats are available. After the tour fills, a waiting list will begin.

TOUR CANCELLATION: If you need to cancel your reservation, written cancellation (email or postal mail) must be sent to Abundant Living. You'll receive confirmation of cancellation. Cancellations are subject to the following fees:

Cancellation by March 1, 2022 - full refund

Cancellation by May 13, 2022 - full refund except for administrative fee (\$150 per person)

Cancellation May 14, 2022 - August 11, 2022 - refund except for deposit (\$500 per person)

Cancellation after August 11, 2022 - no refunds available

ITINERARY CHANGES: It is possible that the daily itinerary may be adjusted because of unforeseen circumstances such as weather. All efforts will be made to stick to the advertised itinerary.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: We recommend the purchase of travel insurance. Many options are available. Speak to your insurance provider to purchase coverage.

MENUS: At least two options will be available at every meal. Menu selections for some of the catered meals will be requested prior to departure. If you have special dietary needs, please communicate those on the registration form. At "on-your-own" mealtimes, participants will be provided with a variety of dining options.

BOAT TOURS: We will take two boat cruises, weather permitting, out on the ocean. If you tend to get motionsick, please consult your doctor about medication options before departure for the tour. If you wish to remain ashore, arrangements will be made for a comfortable place to wait.

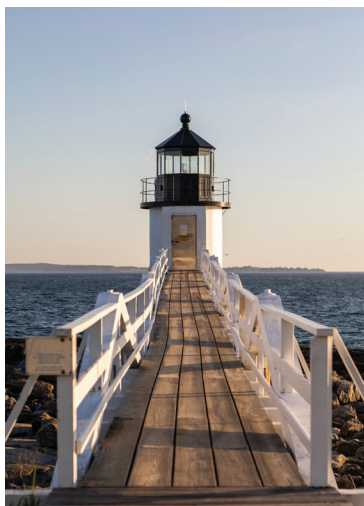

SUNDAY: Arrive in Portland, Maine. Airport transfers provided to Portland Doubletree by Hilton Hotel. Enjoy a gourmet dinner at the hotel followed by a worship and communion service.

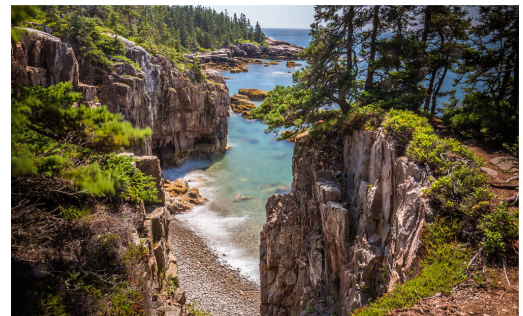
MONDAY: Relax on our luxury coach as you enjoy a guided tour of Portland-area lighthouses, including the iconic Portland Head, the most photographed lighthouse in the country. Catch some rays and explore the pier on stunning Old Orchard Beach before returning to the Doubletree Hotel for another delicious dinner and uplifting worship session.



TUESDAY: Time to load up the coach for three days of exploring the midcoast of Maine. Our day begins by visiting some more beautiful lighthouses including Marshall Point, made famous in the movie "Forrest Gump". Lunch will be served port-side at Rockland Harbor, followed by a tour of the Maine Lighthouse Museum. After checking in to the Rockland Harbor Hotel, you'll be set loose in historic downtown Rockland for dinner on your own.

WEDNESDAY: This exciting day begins with an early departure for the unparalleled Acadia National Park. Our local tour guide will show us amazing spots in the park, including Cadillac Mountain and Thunder Hole. We will grab a quick lunch before departing on a tour of Frenchman Bay aboard The Acadian, in search of eagles, porpoises, seals and other interesting marine wildlife, as well as closeup views of Egg Rock Lighthouse. The day will end with exploring Bar Harbor on your own before tucking in to bed at the well-appointed Atlantic Oceanside Resort.

THURSDAY: After breakfast in Bar Harbor, our tour takes us to the easternmost point in the continental United States – the stunning West Quoddy Head Light. Lunch will be on your own in the quaint fishing village of Lubec where you'll be able to see across the border into New Brunswick, Canada. An restful afternoon ride back to Portland will be welcome after all of the fun exploring the far reaches of Maine. Dinner will be served upon our arrival back at the Doubletree, and an evening of worship will follow.



FRIDAY: Our final day in Maine will begin with a fascinating Whale Watching Tour in Kennebunkport aboard Nick's Chance. Captain Mike will take us to summer feeding grounds for finback, humpback, minke and blue whales. Lunch will be on your own in downtown Kennebunkport, followed by some beachcombing and exploring in Cape Porpoise and Goose Rocks Beach. Our tour will wrap up in the evening with a seafood feast on the water in Portland Harbor and a final time of worship.

SATURDAY: We will say farewell-for-now after breakfast. Airport transfers will be provided, based on flight schedules. Hotel check-out is by 11 a.m.
